Auto insurance board to hear presentations on premium review

Edmonton... The Automobile Insurance Rate Board will hold formal public meetings in Edmonton to review mandatory premiums, as required by Alberta's automobile insurance reform process.

The board's mandate is to annually review premium rates for basic coverage for private passenger vehicles. In setting the maximum premiums, the board will consider industry-wide experience and administrative expenses along with other input provided. The board will reach a decision regarding premiums by August 1. st If rates are to be adjusted, the new rates will take effect on November 1st.
