## **Auto insurance board to hear presentations on premium review**

*Edmonton...* The Automobile Insurance Rate Board (AIRB) will hold formal public meetings in Edmonton to review mandatory premiums. The AIRB will hear presentations from interested stakeholders who made submissions to the board.

The AIRB annually reviews premium rates for basic coverage for private passenger vehicles. In setting the maximum premiums, the board considers industry-wide experience, administrative expenses and other input provided. The AIRB must reach a decision regarding premiums by August 1, and if rates are adjusted, the new rates would take effect on November 1.
