Bridge repairs close lanes near Marwayne

Marwayne... Motorists will expect lane closures and narrow lanes on Highway 897 north of Marwayne.

Starting April 14, the highway bridge over the Vermilion River will undergo repairs to fix damage caused by a recent collision. Traffic will be reduced to one lane during repairs. This lane will be only 4.1 metres wide so vehicles exceeding this width will have to use alternate routes such as Highways 17 or 893. Signage and temporary traffic lights will be in place to guide motorists. Repairs will be complete by April 28, weather permitting.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs and flag persons. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
