Dunvegan Bridge opens to two-lane traffic

Grande Prairie... The Dunvegan Bridge has opened to two-lane traffic for the winter. Construction crews will remain on site in the coming weeks to complete cleanup work and prepare for construction next spring.

Temporary transition ramps have been installed on the bridge, requiring the speed limit to remain at 60 km/hr for the entire length of the bridge.

Alberta Transportation is replacing the concrete deck on the Dunvegan Bridge at a cost of \$17.8 million. Construction and lane reductions will resume in spring 2009 and continue until work is completed in fall 2009.

Motorists are asked to use caution in the area and obey all signs and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
