The CABSESP is unique in Canada in that on-farm assessment for BSE surveillance is performed by certified veterinarians. Registered Alberta veterinarians who want to participate in the CABSESP are required to attend a *Certification Session*. Classroom presentations discuss global implications of BSE, provide a description of the program and describe conditions for on farm implementation as well as demonstrates sample collection, identification and delivery processes.

The CABSESP certification session is offered at no cost and CE credits will be recognized.
