

# 2021 Canada-Alberta Livestock Feed Assistance Initiative Reporting December 17, 2021

Applications for the initial payment under the CALFA AgriRecovery Initiative were launched on September 7, 2021. The table below displays updated numbers on a weekly basis.

## Key points:

- The deadline for applications for the initial phase was November 1, 2021.
- Applications required producers to provide the number of breeding females on hand as of August 6, 2021.
- Producers who have additional costs due to the drought may be eligible to participate in the secondary payment, based on inventory of breeding females as of December 31, 2021.
  - Applications for this secondary payment will be available in early January 2022, and producers are reminded of the importance of keeping accurate records to back up any claim on expenses for the secondary payment portion of this initiative.
