

Screen-based Production Grant (SPG) Program Qualified Production Facilities List

Tier One

A Tier One Production Facility or Studio is a purpose build facility or studio over 15, 000 square feet. **Three points** will be awarded if at least 10 shoot days take place at any of the Tier One facilities.

Tier Two

A Tier Two Production Facility is a purpose built facility under 15,000 square feet or a retro fit or altered space used for productions but not originally built for productions. **Two points** will be awarded if at least 10 shoot days take place at any of the Tier Two facilities.

Tier 3

A Tier Three Production Facility as a non-sound stage or facility used for production. Production revenue may not be the primary source of revenue for the facility. **One point** will be awarded if at least 10 shoot days take place at any of the Tier Three Facilities

Should a production intend to use a facility that meets the definitions as provided above but is not listed in any of the above categories, they need to contact the AMF to obtain an advanced ruling on the eligibility of the intended facility to be included as either a Tier One, Tier Two or Tier Three facility for the purpose of scoring under the Screen Based Production Grant.
