



ALBERTA MADE PRODUCTION GRANT

Insurance Requirements

Applicants approved for funding will be issued a grant agreement. The grant agreement contains information regarding applicant responsibilities as they relate to the grant.

Applicants are responsible for tracking obligations outlined in the grant agreement and meeting all requirements. Failure to do so could result in termination of the grant agreement.

The following insurance requirements form part of the grant agreement:

The Recipient shall, at its own expense and without limiting its liabilities herein, insure its operations under a contract of General Liability Insurance, in accordance with the Alberta Insurance Act, in an amount not less than \$2,000,000 inclusive per occurrence, insuring against bodily injury, personal injury and property damage including loss of use thereof.

The Recipient shall maintain Media Errors and Omissions insurance in an amount not less than \$1 million per claim insuring his liability resulting from errors and omissions in the performance of professional services under this Agreement. Such insurance is required to remain in place for a period of 12 months following the completion or termination of this Agreement. Such insurance shall include copyright infringement.

Applicants **are not required** to submit proof of insurance at the time of application but must maintain appropriate records and accounts necessary to demonstrate the Recipient's compliance with the grant agreement.
