Final Project Declaration Update

The Court of Queen's Bench of Alberta has created workarounds for the commissioning of documents using video technology

As the COVID-19 pandemic continues to impact business processes for many, information is available on how Statutory Declarations required for program reporting may be completed.

- With the approval of the Law Society of Alberta, until further notice, the accommodations will be made for affidavits.
- The Court of Queen's Bench of Alberta will make the decision to the end date of the accommodations.
- As commissioning using video technology is available, applicants who need to complete Statutory Declarations for reporting purposes are asked to use the alternative process.
- Exceptions to waive the commissioning of documents due to COVID-19 will no longer be made.
