## One day pre-emptive testing May 21

Alberta Education held a one-day pre-emptive screening opportunity on May 21. The testing opportunity was offered to public, Catholic and francophone school authorities in Edmonton and Calgary to help identify students and staff who may have COVID-19 but didn't have symptoms before in-class learning resumed. In total, 666 rapid screening tests were conducted in three school boards in Calgary and Edmonton resulting in 28 presumptive positive results. Families were also allowed to get tested with the students that day as they had to bring their children to the testing location.
