

Re-enrollment/Enrollment with MyAlberta Digital ID

Login for Water Use Reporting System changed to MyAlberta Digital ID

The Government of Alberta will be changing the way it provides secure online access to the Water Use Reporting System (WURS). Alberta Secure Access Service (ASAS) is being decommissioned and will be replaced with MyAlberta Digital ID (MADI).

To continue accessing WURS, you will be required to login using a MADI account. If you do not have a MADI account, you will be required to create one.

Once you login using your MADI account, you will be prompted to migrate your Water Use Reporting account information from your old ASAS user ID to your new MADI account.

How to access WURS

Step 1: Create or sign into your MADI account. You are not required to have a verified Digital Id (no valid driver licence is required). Only a basic MADI account is required. When creating your MADI account, if you are an existing ASAS user, use the same email that was used to register with ASAS.

Step 2: Enrolling into WURS

- **Existing WUR User**

If you are an existing WUR user, select the “**Existing ASAS User**” checkbox

1. Enter Last Name (used when you created your MADI account)
2. Enter Email Address

Enrollment Id and Pin Number are not required.

Click the “Re-Enroll in WUR” button.
