Sexual offender released

In the interest of public safety, the Edmonton Police Service is issuing a warning about **Ashton Natomagan** who was released on Monday, Mar. 2, 2015 from the Grande Cache Institution after he completed a 61 Month Sentence for *sexual assault causing bodily harm*.

Natomagan is considered by police to be a sexual offender who poses a risk of significant harm to the community.

Natomagan will be residing in the Edmonton area and will be closely monitored by Correctional Services Canada.
