THE RCMP WARN PUBLIC OF HIGH RISK Violent Sex Offender

The Royal Canadian Mounted Police, in the interest of public safety, is issuing the following information and warning in regard to the release of a Federal inmate for Fort Saskatchewan and Edmonton, Alberta areas.

Chadwick MCCOY will be released from the Regional Psychiatric Centre (RPC) on 2012-06-25, upon completion of his federal sentence, having served 2588 days for Robbery (x3), Sexual Assault, Uttering Threats, Overcome Resistance and Indecent Act. Chadwick has a history of violence toward females, including elderly females and also represents a risk of sexually offending against females over the age of 16 years.

Chadwick MCCOY is described as 39 year-old, Caucasian male, 173cm (68.1in.), 75kg (165lbs), with brown eyes and blonde hair and will be residing in the Fort Saskatchewan, Alberta area.

Chadwick MCCOY has been convicted of numerous violent criminal offences: Assault with a Weapon, Attempted Robbery, Robbery (x5), Sexual Assault (x2), Overcome Resistance, Uttering Threats, Committing an Indecent Act.

The RCMP are issuing this information and warning after careful deliberation and consideration of all related issues, including privacy concerns, in the belief that it is clearly in the public interest to inform the members of the community of the release of **Chadwick MCCOY**. The RCMP believes that there is a risk of significant harm to the health or safety of the public, and in particular, females of all ages.

Members of the public are advised that the intent of the process is to enable members of the public to take suitable precautionary measures and not to embark on any form of vigilante action. Anyone believing that a crime has been or is about to be committed is encouraged to call police. If the matter is felt to be of an urgent nature please call 911 to report the location circumstances.
