Public information and warning: Sexual Offender Released

In the interest of public safety, the Edmonton Police Service is issuing the following warning; Robin STONEY was recently released from federal custody after he completed an eight (8) year sentence for Sexual Assault and Attempted Sexual Assault.

Mr. STONEY is considered by police to be a High Risk Offender who poses a risk of significant harm to the community. Mr. STONEY has accessed the Edmonton River valley in the past and committed offences in that area.

The Edmonton Police Service is issuing this information and warning after careful deliberation of all related issues, including privacy concerns, in the belief that it is clearly in the public interest to inform the members of the community. Mr. STONEY will be residing in the Edmonton area and will be supervised by Correctional Service of Canada.
