Public information and warning: Violent Offender Released

In the interest of public safety, the Edmonton Police Service is issuing the following warning: **William Teddy Stanley** was released from the Regional Psychiatric Center (RPC) Saskatoon, after serving his entire 5 year, 3 months, and 26 day sentence for traffic in a scheduled substance, fail to comply with recognizance, robbery X 3, assault, assault causing bodily harm and forcible confinement.

Stanley is considered by police to be a violent offender who continues to present a high probability of returning to violent behavior. He clearly poses a risk of significant harm to the community and is a high risk to re-offend violently. It's believed that Stanley intends to make Edmonton his home upon release.

The Edmonton Police Service is issuing this information and warning after careful deliberation of all related issues, including privacy concerns, in the belief that it is clearly in the public interest to inform the members of the community about Stanley.



William Teddy STANLEY (32 years old)

Native male, 32 years old, 6'1" (185 cm), 203 lbs.(92 kg), black hair, brown eyes, moustache and beard. He has tattoos of Skeletons, Skulls and Joker on his right forearm and King, Crown and Dragon on his left forearm.

Members of the public are advised that the intent of this process is to enable citizens to take suitable precautionary measures. Releasing this information is NOT intended to encourage people to engage in any form of vigilante action.
