

**S.E.F. No. 6c Revised**  
**PUBLIC PASSENGER VEHICLES ENDORSEMENT**

In consideration of a premium of \$ ..... it is understood and agreed as follows:

1. Permission is hereby given for the automobile to be used to carry passengers for compensation or hire;
2. Only as respects loss or damage resulting from bodily injury to, or the death of, any occupant of the automobile and, only as respects loss of or damage to property carried in or upon the automobile, while the automobile is being so used

(i) Exclusions (b) and (d) of section A of the Insuring Agreements of this Policy are amended to read as follows; -

\* (b) for loss or damage resulting from bodily injury to or the death of any person insured by this Policy; or  
(d) for loss of or damage to any property owned or rented by any person insured by this Policy; or

(ii) The Insurer's limits of liability shall be:

(a) \$.....(exclusive of interest and costs) for loss or damage resulting from bodily injury to or the death of any one such person and, subject to such limit for any one such person so injured or killed,

\$.....(exclusive of interest and costs) for loss or damage resulting from bodily injury to or the death of two or more such persons in any one accident, and

\$.....(exclusive of interest and costs) for loss or damage to property resulting from any one accident;

or

(b) \$.....(exclusive of interest and costs) in respect to bodily injury to or the death of one or more passengers.

Such limit(s) of liability shall apply instead of the limits stated in section A of item 4 of the Application and shall be in addition to the limit(s) applicable to loss resulting from bodily injury to or the death of any other person(s) or damage to any other property.

If more than one automobile is insured under this policy, this endorsement shall apply only to the automobile(s) described under item(s) number ..... of the schedule of automobiles attached to and forming part of this policy.

Except as otherwise provided in this endorsement, all limits, terms, conditions, provisions, definitions and exclusions of the policy shall have full force and effect.

## **TO: All Automobile Insurers Licensed in Alberta**

**Re: SEF No. 6c Public Passenger Vehicle Endorsement**

**and**

**SEF No. 101 Public Passenger Vehicle Endorsement**

Effective immediately the SEF No. 6c and SEF No. 101 endorsements are amended by removing the following wording from section 2(ii)(b) of the SEF No. 6c endorsement and from section 1 (b) of the SEF No. 101 endorsement

... “and losses of or damage to the passengers’ property in one accident”.

The amendment will apply immediately to all SEF No. 6c and SEF No. 101 endorsements that are in force, issued or renewed.

The amendment is necessary so that policyholders can meet the passenger hazard insurance requirement imposed by regulations under the *Traffic Safety Act*.

Please alert your underwriting staff and Alberta insurance agents of the revisions to the SEF No. 6c and SEF No. 101 endorsements.
