Cold Lake First Nations	Casino Dene Limited Partnership	Live Entertainment, Lounge and Restaurant Renovations	Funding will provide the organization more gaming floor space to increase capacity and relocation of the existing stage for live entertainment.
Enoch Cree Nation	Cistemaw Wholesale Corp.	Enoch Cree Nation Wholesale Tobacco Company project	Funding will provide the corporation with resources to construct a tobacco warehouse and distribution centre on Enoch Cree Nation.
