

## Candidates who do not apply for certification within two years after their examination are at risk of losing their credentials.

- For training prior to 2016, official Lakeland College transcripts are required.
- Medical training qualifications must be supported with official documentation; e.g., wallet card from approved first aid training agency, ACP practice permit.
- For NFPA credentials obtained outside Alberta, a copy of the official Pro Board or IFSAC certificate must be submitted.

## NFPA 472 Competence of Responders to Hazardous Materials/Weapons of Mass Destruction Incidents

NFPA 472 transitioned to NFPA 1072 in June 2019. Existing NFPA 472 certifications will continue to be recognized as a valid prerequisite to other NFPA certifications. Candidates who already hold NFPA 472 certificates do not need to update to NFPA 1072. Refer to NFPA 1072 prerequisites.

**MEDICAL TRAINING REQUIREMENT:** Fire Fighter levels I and II require current certification in Standard First Aid with CPR "C" or more advanced qualifications; e.g., Advanced First Aid, EMR, PCP, ACP. See Alberta Labour's list of approved first aid training providers for first aid training in the workplace.

#### NFPA 1006 (2013) Standard for Rescue Technician Professional Qualifications

MEDICAL TRAINING REQUIREMENT: All 1006 levels require current certification in one of the following:

- Emergency Medical Responder, Primary Care Paramedic, Advanced Care Paramedic (current with the Alberta College of Paramedics or completed within the last 3 years)
- Medical First Responder, Emergency Medical Responder, Advanced Adventure Medic/Wilderness First Responder OR Advanced First Aid (SJA or Red Cross). See Alberta Labour's list of <u>approved first aid training</u> <u>providers for first aid training in the workplace</u>.

Official documentation must be provided; e.g., copy of the wallet card, Practice Permit.
