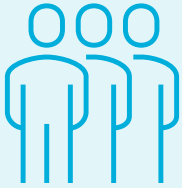


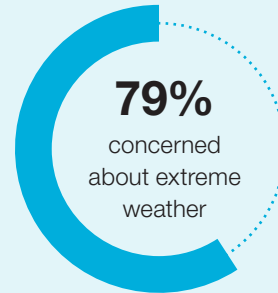
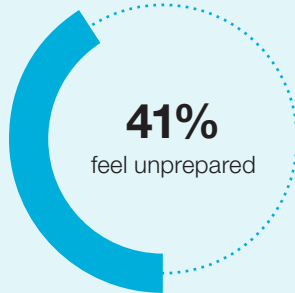

Reasons for not being prepared include

- Need more information
- Lack of money
- Haven't thought about it
- Procrastination
- Low risk perception
- Not enough time

COVID-19 impacts include

52%

feel COVID-19 influenced their preparedness

41%

see the importance of being more self-reliant

41%

see the value in planning ahead

Community connections

90%

would help someone in their community who was affected by an emergency or disaster

82%

of those who live in a rural place would feel comfortable asking for help, compared to 70% of those in an urban place

83%

would have somewhere to stay if forced to evacuate

71%

would ask for help from someone in their community

Preparedness behaviours



Know the risks

38% are aware of the risks in their community



Start a conversation

34% have discussed preparedness with their network



Stay informed

61% receive public alerts and emergency messaging



Make a plan

27% have a household plan and 24% are aware of emergency procedures at facilities for their loved ones



Financial resilience

54% have proper insurance and 50% have an emergency fund



Community connections

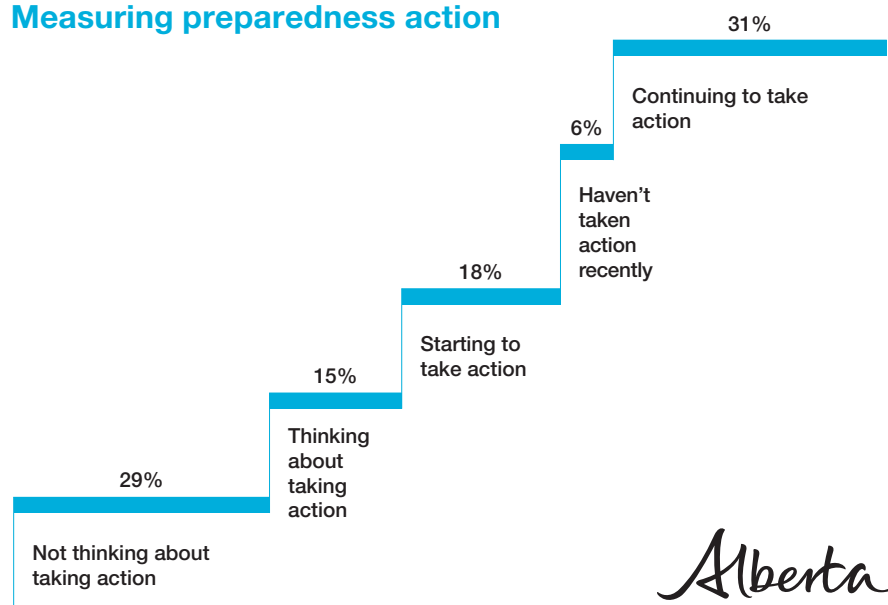
10% have made a neighbourhood contact list



Gather supplies

26% have an emergency kit and 51% have enough supplies to shelter in place
