Stream Definition:	The work in this stream is primarily working with children and youth in both secure and open care centres. For the most part, this work is performed within a multi-disciplinary team, and is focused on ensuring the treatment or care plan developed by the team for each child is followed. Work in this stream is often focused on hands-on, front-line counseling in a centre. This stream also includes the supervision of the front-line function, as well as the work done in outreach situations where assistance is provided in homes. The goal is to maintain or re-establish the family unit.
