Work in this Stream involves developing and leading the implementation of specialized rehabilitative plans for individuals through meaningful activities and therapeutic interventions in a variety of daily living situations or consulting with other professionals in the rehabilitative field.

For positions in Recreational Therapy: Directly related two (2) year diploma and two (2) years of related experience or a degree related to the position assignment.

Minimum Recruitment Standard:

- Directly related two (2) year diploma or a degree related to the position assignment and four (4) years of related experience.

For positions in Recreational Therapy: Directly related two (2) year diploma and four (4) years of related experience or a degree related to the position assignment and two (2) years of related experience.

Rehabilitation 4

Minimum Recruitment Standard:

- Degree related to the position assignment and three (3) years of related experience. Must be a regulated member of the appropriate college if required by the Health Professions Act.

Equivalency: Directly related education considered on the basis of 1 year of education for 1 year of experience. Must be a regulated member of the appropriate college if required by the Health Professions Act.

For positions in Recreational Therapy: Directly related two (2) year diploma and six (6) years of related experience or a degree related to the position assignment and four (4) years of related experience.
