



**DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION
REGISTRAR'S EXEMPTION
OPERATING AUTHORITY CERTIFICATES**

The Registrar, pursuant to the authority vested in her under section 10(2.1) of the Commercial Vehicle Certificate and Insurance Regulation AR 314/2002, hereby exempts commercial vehicles, required to operate under the authority of an operating authority certificate, in accordance with section 10(1) of the Commercial Vehicle Certificate and Insurance Regulation (AR 314/2002), from the requirement to operate under the authority of an operator authority certificate, subject to the below terms and conditions.

Terms and Conditions

- This exemption is only valid within the Province of Alberta.
- The holder of this exemption must otherwise be authorized to operate a commercial vehicle, as defined in section 10 of the Commercial Vehicle Certificate and Insurance Regulation AR 211/2006, and hold all other necessary certificates or passenger hazard insurance to operate a passenger transportation vehicle.
- Operators must exercise due care at all times. Alberta Transportation assumes no responsibility for whatever may occur or as a result of the operation of the commercial vehicle. The exemption holder is responsible for all claims and damages occurring during, or resulting from, either the use or intended use of the passenger vehicle.
- Operators must hold a valid operator's licence of the class required to operate the particular passenger vehicle being driven (either a Class 1, 2 or 4 operator's licence). The operator must be knowledgeable in the safe manual operation of the passenger vehicle.
- The operation of a commercial vehicle, pursuant to the exemption, must abide by all requirements for the operation of that commercial vehicle as though an operating authority certificate was required or had been issued in relation to the operation of that commercial vehicle, including, but not limited to those requirements described in section 20 of the Vehicle Inspection Regulation AR 211/2006 and section 26 of the Commercial Vehicle Certificate and Insurance Regulation AR 314/2002.
- The Registrar may amend, suspend or cancel this exemption for any reason.

This exemption comes into force on January 2, 2020 expires on January 2, 2023.
