APPENDIX B: CROSSTAB DEFINITIONS AND WEIGHTINGS

CROSSTAB DEFINITIONS ■

To assist in analysis, data tables divide participant responses into a series of crosstabs which are defined as follows:

- AB F** Females residing in the province of Alberta, as calculated from gender and postal code responses.
- AB M** Males residing in the province of Alberta, as calculated from gender and postal code responses.
- AB 18-24** Individuals aged 18 to 24 in the province of Alberta, as calculated from age group and postal code responses.
- AB 25-34** Individuals aged 25 to 34 in the province of Alberta, as calculated from age group and postal code responses.
- AB 35-44** Individuals aged 35 to 44 in the province of Alberta, as calculated from age group and postal code responses.
- AB 45-54** Individuals aged 45 to 54 in the province of Alberta, as calculated from age group and postal code responses.
- AB 55-64** Individuals aged 55 to 64 in the province of Alberta, as calculated from age group and postal code responses.
- AB 65-74** Individuals aged 65 to 74 in the province of Alberta, as calculated from age group and postal code responses.
- AB 75+** Individuals over 75 years of age in the province of Alberta, as calculated from age group and postal code responses.
- YEG** Responses from the Edmonton Metropolitan region as calculated from postal code responses and defined by the following postal code forward sortation areas (or FSAs):
