Enforcement order issued to gas plant operator

Edmonton... The Government of Alberta has issued an enforcement order to SemCAMS ULC., operator of Kaybob South Beaverhill Lake Unit Number 3 sour gas plant in Woodlands County for failing to maintain effective operations of air monitoring equipment.

One of the facility's ambient air quality analyzers has not been operating in a reliable manner, resulting in non-compliance with Alberta's *Air Monitoring Directive* on a number of occasions. Under the enforcement order, the company will be required to conduct a third party review and audit of the faulty analyzer to ensure it is functioning properly, in order to bring the company into compliance with their operating approval.

Enforcement orders are issued under the authority of Alberta's *Environmental Protection and Enhancement Act*. The Alberta government can issue enforcement orders to remedy a number of environmental problems where the acts have been contravened.
