Overview/Description

Fireline Leadership is designed to develop leadership skills for supervisors involved in wildfire operations.

Topics Include:

- Leading in dynamic work environments, examining strengths and weaknesses as a leader, performing and decision making in high-stress situations and building a cohesive team.

The goal of this course is to empower supervisors with the ability to build, train, and maintain effective wildfire crews through a purposeful and holistic approach to leadership.

Target Audience

Employees who have supervisor roles in fireline operations.

This course is ideal for Wildfire Crew Leaders and Strike Team/Task Force Leaders.

There are no prerequisites; however, candidates who have some experience as fireline supervisors are preferred.
