



# Online Logistics Series

## Overview/Description

The Online Logistics Series is made up of 8 courses.

### Logistics Series 1 – Logistics Section Overview

This course provides an overview of the Logistics Section and Logistics Section Chief position. Included are roles and responsibilities, mobilization, establishment, daily operations and demobilization. Individuals will gain base level knowledge and practical skills needed for incident deployment.

### Logistics Series 2 – Facilities Unit

This course provides an overview of the Facilities Unit and Facilities Unit Leader position. Included are roles and responsibilities, unit establishment, unit personnel, facilities and demobilization. Individuals will gain base level knowledge and practical skills needed for incident deployment.

### Logistics Series 3 – Communications Unit

This course provides an overview of the Communications Unit and Communications Unit Leader position. Included are roles and responsibilities, unit establishment, arrival and initial briefing, incident command trailers, internet data services and ICS 205. Individuals will gain base level knowledge and practical skills needed for deployment.

### Logistics Series 4 – Supply Unit

This course provides an overview of the Supply Unit and Facilities Unit Leader position. Included are roles and responsibilities, unit establishment, arrival and initial briefing, unit personnel, equipment and supplies and FP131-Inventory Order Form. Individuals will gain base level knowledge and practical skills needed for incident deployment.

### Logistics Series 5 – Medical Unit

This course provides an overview of the Medical Unit and Medical Unit Leader position. Included are roles and responsibilities, unit establishment, arrival and initial briefing, unit personnel, equipment and supplies, medical services contracts, medical plan, medivac plan, and internal and external coordination. Individuals will gain base level knowledge and practical skills needed for incident deployment.

### Logistics Series 6 – Ground Support

This course provides an overview of the Ground Support Unit and Ground Support Unit Leader position. Included are roles and responsibilities, unit establishment, arrival and initial briefing, unit personnel, equipment and supplies, fireline and mobile equipment rental agreement, release of equipment and demobilization. Individuals will gain base level knowledge and practical skills needed for incident deployment.

### Logistics Series 7 – Area Logistics

This course provides an overview of Area Logistics and Area Logistics positions. Included are roles and responsibilities, area briefing, ordering procedures, personnel heavy equipment and fireline equipment orders, processing resource requests, demobilization. Individuals will gain base level knowledge and practical skills needed for incident deployment.

### Logistics Series 8 – Provincial Logistics

This course provides an overview of the Provincial Logistics and the Provincial Logistics positions. Included are role of provincial logistics, resource request processing, preparedness levels, AWCC logistics organization and resource sharing agreement.
