Overview/Description

The Prevention 1 Series is available for Forestry Division staff and includes 4 courses: Fire Permits, FireSmart Principles, The Fire Ban System and Introduction to Public Engagement.

Prevention 1 – The Fire Ban System

The Fire Ban System course provides a comprehensive overview of the Fire Ban System. Topics include, purpose of Fire Ban System, roles and responsibilities, levels of fire control, and public perception and messaging.

Prevention 1 – FireSmart Principles

The FireSmart Principles course provides an overview of FireSmart Canada and Alberta FireSmart, details of the seven FireSmart disciplines and access to helpful resources.

Prevention 1 - Introduction to Public Engagement

Introduction to Public Engagement details how to support wildfire prevention initiatives through effective public education and engagement.

Prevention 1 – Fire Permits

The Fire Permits course reviews the procedures used to prepare and issue a fire permit. Including progression of a fire permit, sizing up a request, fuel engineering standards, writing a permit, denied permits, extension or cancelled permits as well as scenarios
