- With the Business Assessment and Action Tool (BAAT) you can evaluate operational performance as it relates to industry best practices.
- The assessment is an interactive conversation, involving the key people in your organization, led by the AF development officer, and takes approximately two hours.
- The results of this assessment will help you decide where the largest opportunities for growth exist.
- The action plan helps you prioritize the areas of your business to address during the next one to three years. The session to develop the action plan may take two hours.

- Help you to identify the largest opportunities for growth, efficiency gains and risk reduction.
- Assist you in making an action plan and moving toward the desired outcome.
