Overview/Description

Principles of Fire Behaviour is an intermediate level fire behaviour course that builds on pre-existing fire behaviour knowledge and was mandated by the Canadian Interagency Forest Fire Centre (CIFFC). Principles of Fire Behaviour is a skill course designed to instruct you in wildland fire behaviour for effective and safe fire management. This course will help you anticipate fire behaviour based on a number of observable and measurable behaviours.
