



S131 Online Module 12: Helicopter Operations (CIFFC)

Overview/Description

This course will teach you the basics of working around Helicopters in the field. Once you have completed this course you will be able to do the following:

- Identify danger areas of a helicopter
- Demonstrate safe procedures for approaching, boarding, exiting and departing from a helicopter.
- Demonstrate how to prepare equipment for slinging in a cargo net.
- Demonstrate how to properly load a cargo net ready for safely hooking to a helicopter.
- Demonstrate safe procedures for internal loading and unloading of a helicopter.
- Describe the requirements for clearing a helistop and constructing a helipad.
- Describe hazards associated with being caught in a helicopter bucketing drop zone.
