



Industry Dozer Boss

Overview/Description

This course presents the information required to make effective use of bulldozers and heavy equipment in the construction of dozer fireguards and helispots. This includes safety considerations, wildfire assessment, attack methods, fire behaviour, strategies, tactics and administration. As well the safety considerations associated with power lines, pipelines, and airtanker operations are also reviewed. Reclamation and environmental concerns are highlighted throughout the course.

Target Audience

Woods Operations Foremen and Dozer/Construction Company Foremen, preferably with some firefighting experience as Dozer Operators.

Prerequisites

- Online Introduction to ICS I-100
- Industry Canada Radio Operators Certificate
- Online Mapping Standards and Practice

Students must complete Online ICS I-100 and review the Industry Canada Radio Operators Licence study guide. The radio operators licence exam will be given with the final course exam. (Students with either or both of these will be required to show proof of completion).
