



FI-210 Wildfire Origin and Cause Determination

Overview/Description

This course ocuses on the process of locating fire origin and determining fire cause.

Classroom instruction will cover the theory of using fire patterns to locate the ignition point of a fire and executive report preparation. Identification procedures and techniques will be addressed through formal lectures and case studies. Students will have the opportunity to apply classroom techniques through practical exercises and field labs.

Target Audience

Agriculture and Forestry employees; government - approved investigators; county, MD, ID fire employees; and law enforcement officers responsible for wildfire investigation.
