



Crew Resource Management – Train the Trainer

Overview/Description

The Crew Resource Management - Train the Trainer introduces the principles associated with Transport Canada's Crew Resource Management requirements. It covers the core elements set out by Transport Canada. These include; Threat and Error Management, Communication, Situational Awareness, Pressure and Stress, Fatigue, Workload Management, Decision Making and Leadership and Team Building. This course is designed so that CRM can be delivered in the Areas using the CRM pamphlet by individuals who have taken this course.

Primary Target Group

All wildfire Management Branch staff that will be flying in or talking to aircraft. This includes any permanent, wage, or seasonal staff that deal with or interact with aircraft.

Target Audience

Agriculture and Forestry employees involved in the effective and efficient management of wildfires, from initial attack crews to upper management.

Prerequisites

Successful completion of the Incident Command System I-200. Preferred to have Adult Instructor Course and an operational back ground.
