Prescribed Fire Planning

Overview/Description

The purpose of Prescribed Fire Planning is to prepare candidates to write a prescribed fire plan with moderate complexity.

This is a four and a half day course that takes candidates through the basic steps of preparing a plan.

Candidates will be required to complete a pre-course assignment that will include a fire behaviour exercise and a critique of a prescribed fire plan.

Target Audience

This course is suggested training for all individuals who are involved or plan to be involved in the preparation of prescribed fire plans.

Prerequisites

- Advanced Wildland Fire Behaviour course
- Certified as Incident Commander 3 or Task Force Leader.
- Satisfactory completion of a pre-course assignment.
