



# Reforestation Monitoring

## Overview/Description

A comprehensive and consistent provincial reforestation monitoring program is a critical component to ensuring the sustainability of Alberta's public forests.

This course addresses the principles of sustainable forest management through confirming whether the desired future forest condition as committed to in each forest management plan was achieved by the end of the reforestation phase (year 14).

Reforestation monitoring procedures are described, demonstrated, and practiced using classroom (35%), computer lab (5%), and field exercises (60%). Reforestation monitoring outcomes and implications for sustainable forest management are discussed.
