



Safety Officer

Overview/Description

The purpose of this course is to train candidates on the general responsibilities and specific duties required to be a Safety Officer assigned to a wildfire.

Topics include:

- OHS program and legislation, identifying and responding to hazards and incidents, developing safety plans, and working alongside the IMT. Candidates will be working directly with the Safety Officer reference material.

Target Audience

Employees or individuals contracted by Wildfire Management Branch (WMB), who meet the prerequisites and will be activated in the role of Safety Officer or Safety Officer Assistant.

Candidates who have STL/TFL certification and OHS experience are preferred.

Prerequisites

Valid certification in:

- Transportation of Dangerous Goods TDG (air and ground).
- Online WHMIS.
