



Scaling Refresher 105

Overview/Description

Scaling 105 is designed to allow permitted scalers to renew their permit without repeating the full scaling course. This course is an intensive, quick review, followed by a written and practical exam.

Individuals who successfully pass the course are eligible to receive an Alberta scaler's permit, valid for a period of five years.

Full-time production scalers who have scaled a minimum of 75 loads annually in the last five years (based on department records) have the option to recertify through completing an online department scaling course, passing an online exam, and passing a check scale administered by Forest Management Branch staff.

Target Audience

Permitted scalers wanting to renew their timber scaling permit in the province of Alberta. Scalers must complete the Scaling Refresher course within two years of the expiry date on their permit.

Prerequisites

- Minimum of 18 years of age.
- Permitted scalers. Those who do not scale regularly may find attending the full course Scaling 100 more suitable.
- Online pre-course.
