## The Canada and Alberta BSE Surveillance Program (CABSESP)

The CABSESP is unique in Canada in that on-farm assessment for BSE surveillance is performed by certified veterinarians. Registered Alberta veterinarians who want to participate in the CABSESP are required to attend a *Certification Session*. Classroom presentations discuss global implications of BSE, provide a description of the program, and describe conditions for on farm implementation. A wet lab training demonstrates sample collection, identification, and delivery processes.

Graduates from the UCVI who attended the BSE pre-certification session during the regulatory medicine course are not required to attend this session. Please contact Dr. Chunu Mainali if you are pre-certified and would like to request full certification.

The CABSESP certification session is offered at no cost and CE credits will be recognized (where applicable). Registration is required to participate in this session.
