Get temporary coverage for opioid dependency treatment medications

Opioid agonist therapy (OAT) reduces cravings for opioids and helps manage withdrawal symptoms.

If you do not have health benefit coverage, the OAT Gap Coverage Program will cover your medication costs for 120 days at no cost while you enroll in a health benefit plan.

Enrolment in the program is automatic. You only need to provide your pharmacy with your Alberta Personal Health Number and a valid prescription.
