Site Boundary Shapefiles

Site boundary shapefiles MUST be provided for ALL sites regardless of their size. The projected coordinate system for the shapefiles must be in 10-TM (Forest) (EPSG: 3400) projection. Site boundaries must be a minimum of 10 m in all directions to account for GPS error. Extents larger than 20 m in diameter will not be accepted for isolated find sites. If more than one site is being reserved for the same permit, one shapefile with multiple records should be submitted for the permit. GIS shapefile(s) (ex. siteboundary.dbf, siteboundary.prj, siteboundary.sbn, siteboundary.sbx, siteboundary.shp, siteboundary.shx) should be compiled into a .zip file and e-mailed to the Archaeological Information Coordinator along with the filled out Borden Number Reservation Application. The shapefile(s) attribute table must have a 'Field No' field. The Field No entered in the shapefile attribute table must match the "Field_No" entered on the reservation form.

For non-ESRI users, site boundary shapefiles can be created using QGIS (a free open source GIS program).

Borden Reservation Instructions:

To use this form, fill out all applicable fields. Multiple site types and/or feature or artifact types can be selected. Complete the Borden No. field only if you are updating a site location.

Please limit the records you send in one document to new or updated sites (i.e., Do not resubmit all of your site records each time).
