Required Information

1. Receiver's name and address. Contact person, telephone and fax number.

- 2. Location(s) in Alberta, which will receive imported material.
 - a. Type of material to be handled at each site.
 - b. Provide the Permits/Licenses/Approvals held or applied for at receiving locations from any regulatory agency.
- 3. Provide a description of the waste for importation (e.g., classification, source, and phase).
- 4. Estimated the annual amount to be imported for storage (e.g., operating capacity utilized by imports).
- 5. A general description of hazardous waste to be transferred off-site, name and location of receiver(s).

Desirable Information

- 1. Economic value of waste. Importance of waste to facility viability. Any incremental new investment required to handle imported fraction.
- 2. Incremental environmental impact resulting from storing imported material.

<u>Note</u>: A hazardous waste manifest is required for all transborder shipments; therefore, a Personal Identification Number (receiver number) will also be required. Applications for this number can be obtained from the Waste Policy Branch.
