# ORDER PURSUANT TO SECTION 234(1) OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AND ENHANCEMENT ACT

**WHEREAS** Darcy B. Dobrosky has pled guilty to an offence under the *Environmental Protection and Enhancement Act*, to wit:

### Count 2:

On or between the 1st day of April, 2009 and the 8th day of March, 2016, at or near the Town of Oyen, in the Province of Alberta, did fail to monitor potable water in a waterworks system at random locations within the water distribution system contrary to s. 5.1.4 of the *Code of Practice for a Waterworks System Consisting Solely of a Water Distribution System* and did thereby commit an offence contrary to section 227(e) of the *Environmental Protection and Enhancement Act*, notice of the offence having first come to the attention of the Director on March 9, 2016.

**AND WHEREAS** in addition to a fine of \$1,000.00 as against Darcy B. Dobrosky, imposed under the *Environmental Protection and Enhancement Act*, inclusive of victim fine surcharge.

#### IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. Pursuant to the provisions of section 234(1)(a) of the *Environmental Protection and Enhancement Act*, for a period of 3 years from the date of

this Order, Darcy B. Dobrosky shall not:

- a. Operate or have control of any facility or system for the collection, treatment, or distribution of water or wastewater in the Province of Alberta; and
- b. Be employed or hold a controlling interest in any corporation or other organization owning or operating a water or wastewater collection, treatment, or distribution system located in Alberta.
