Right of Entry Most Recent Written Offer Instructions

Documents may be sent electronically to the Tribunal. You are required to keep a copy of the original documents on file until a decision of the Tribunal has issued regarding your application for Right of Entry.

Most Recent Written Offer:

- Copy of most recent written offer made by the Applicant to a Respondent and evidence the offer has been refused (s. 15(2)(a) of the Surface Rights Act)
- Copy of most recent written offer must be made within 12 months (see section 14 (1.1) of the Surface Rights Rules) of submitting your COMPLETED application. Deficient applications are not considered complete.
- Applicant/Respondent information must be consistent with the Schedule 1 Application
- Land description must be consistent with the Schedule 1 Application
- Acreage/plan must match Schedule 1 Application
- Most Recent Written Offer must be attached to Declaration as appendix see below

Declaration of Most Recent Written Offer must be enclosed:

- Select the applicable type of service from the available options:
 PERONALLY, REGISTERED MAIL, PERSONALLY ON REP/COUNSEL,
 REGISTERED MAIL ON REP/COUNSEL or EMAIL ON REP/COUNSEL
- Applicant and Respondent(s) to whom offer was made must be consistent with the Schedule 1 Application
- Must be served on a Respondent(s) (see <u>Rule 17 of the Surface Rights Rules</u> for how service may be accomplished)
- If service is by email or fax to the **respondent's counsel**, a copy of email or fax must be attached to the Declaration as an appendix.
- If service is by registered mail, the post master receipt must be attached to the Declaration as an appendix.
- Tribunal administration does not accept service via email directly upon the respondent.

Classification: Public

Type of Service	May be refused if no response received after:
Personal	7 clear days
Email/fax on legal counsel	7 clear days from receipt of email or next day (whichever is sooner)
Registered mail within Alberta	14 clear days
Registered mail outside Alberta	21 clear days

- To be refused by registered mail the offer must have been served to all addresses on the Schedule 1 Application
- Once the document is digitally <u>signed and saved</u>, it can no longer be edited.
