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## Right of Entry Survey Plan Instructions

Documents may be sent electronically to the Tribunal. You are required to keep a copy of the original documents on file until a decision of the Tribunal has issued regarding your application for Right of Entry.

## Survey Plan: (refer to the Surface Rights Act General Regulation)

- Land description must be consistent with the Schedule 1 Application.
- Plan must be prepared by a surveyor or engineer showing the location, dimensions and acreage of the land required coloured or outlined in red. Where the land required is for a pipeline, power transmission line or telephone line the location, dimensions and acreage of the land must be coloured or outlined in green.

Example – a wellsite and access road would be outlined/coloured in red with the wellhead coordinates listed on the plan.

- Please ensure any reference to red or green on your plan is only for the area you are applying. Any other areas should be outlined/coloured in another colour. Please note that yellow is used for termination applications.
- Note: If you are applying for a pad site please <u>provide one plan</u> outlined in red indicating each well site location and the surface coordinates for each well site you are applying.
- Where a Schedule 1 Application for a right of entry order has more than one plan attached, the Schedule 1 Application must refer to each plan by letter or number and the plans must be identified by the corresponding letter or number - (refer to <u>S. 9 of the</u> <u>Surface Rights Act General Regulation</u>) (eg. Plan A and Plan B OR Plan 1 and Plan 2).
- Plan must be attached as an appendix to the Declaration in Support of Survey Plan(s) and forms part of the Schedule 1 Application.
- To assist with the timely processing of Schedule 1 applications for right of entry, Tribunal Administration requests that the Schedule 1 applications incorporate the following certification on plans submitted pursuant to Section 6 of the Surface Rights Act General Regulation:

## **Declaration in Support of Survey Plan(s):**

- Attach to Plan(s) that form part of the Schedule 1 Application
- Approval/Permit/Licence number(s) must match Schedule 1 Application
- Colour indicated must match plan (refer to <u>s. 6 of the Surface Rights Act General Regulation</u> for appropriate colour)

Surface Rights Act General Regulation

- **6(1)** An application for a right of entry order must be accompanied by a plan of survey prepared by an Alberta land surveyor and affixed with the surveyor's signature or stamp.
- (2) The plan must show the location, dimensions and acreage of the land required coloured or outlined in red.
- (3) Notwithstanding subsection (2), where the land required is for a pipeline, power transmission line or telephone line, the location, dimensions and acreage of the land must be coloured or outlined in green.
- Once the document is digitally <u>signed and saved</u>, it can no longer be edited.
