

Premium Rate Sheet

A Benefits Program for Government of Alberta Managers and Non-Union Employees

Effective June 25, 2023

The premium rates are in effect as of <u>June 25, 2023</u> and are subject to change from time to time. All premiums are based on a bi-weekly rate, except for the Core and Enhanced Life Insurance.

Group Life Insurance Plan

The rates for Core and Enhanced Life Insurance are per month. The monthly rates are deducted on a bi-weekly basis. The bi-weekly deductions are calculated by annualizing the monthly premium (multiply the rate by 12), and dividing it by the number of pay periods in the calendar year.
