Upon the recommendation of the Honourable Provincial Treasurer, the Lieutenant Governor in Council, pursuant to section 74 of the Financial Administration Act, authorizes the giving by the Crown of the following indemnities:

- 1. The Crown shall, to the extent each member or former member of the Executive Council of Alberta is not otherwise indemnified, indemnify the member against all costs, charges and expenses, including amounts paid to settle actions or satisfy judgements, reasonably incurred by the member in respect of civil, criminal or administrative actions or proceedings to which the member is made a party by reason of holding or having held that office if the member acted honestly and in good faith with a view to the best interests of the public, complies with the Appendix and, in the case of a criminal or administrative action or proceeding enforceable by a monetary penalty, had reasonable grounds for believing that the member's conduct was lawful.
- 2. With the approval of the Treasury Board, the Crown may give indemnities, including at least the terms of and conditions applicable to indemnities under section 1 to individuals by their personal names, names of office or classes, who are or were members of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, employees of the Crown, members of provincial committees, members or directors of Provincial corporations or members, directors or officers at the Crown's request of corporations or unincorporated bodies and their heirs and legal representatives.
