This Decision relates to child support in the order/agreement dated October 12, 2001 ("the Order") relating to the following children:

The Child Support Recalculation Program (RP) has recalculated the guideline income of the payor as \$47,500.00 and the guideline income of the recipient as \$62,000.00. Pursuant to section 55.31 of the *Family Law Act*, there will be no change in child support. This is because RP's calculations did not show a difference of at least \$10 in the monthly amount of support to be paid, or a difference of at least 10% in a party's share of special or extraordinary expenses.
