

Registrar's Decisions: Notification (RDN) 01/2022: New Products: Specialized Business Functions (SBF) Motor Vehicle Information Products (MVIPs) - Incremental Decision

Access to Motor Vehicle Information Regulation (AMVIR)

I. Decisions

To comply with the requirements of the Access to Motor Vehicle Information Regulation (AMVIR) AR 140/2003, as amended, and to further strengthen, clarify, and manage the disclosure of personal information from Alberta's Motor Vehicle Electronic System (MOVES), the Registrar of Motor Vehicle Services (the "Registrar") decides to amend the Registrar's Decisions: Notification 04/2020 as follows:

1. Replace the following text in section 6. Specialized Business Functions MVIPs:

B. Operator (Driver) Licensing Information SBF-RR MVIPs:

None.

with the following text:

B. Operator (Driver) Licensing Information SBF-RR MVIPs:

SBF-RR OI-DMIS: Operator (Driver) Information, Driver's Licensing Status for the Driver Management Information System

2. Append at the end of section 7 the following text describing a new MVIP:

7.8. SBF-RR OI-DMIS: Operator (Driver) Information, Driver's Licensing Status for GoA Driver Management Information System

This type of SBF-RR MVIP uses the driver's licence number and date of birth to answer the question: "*What is the current licensing status of a Government of Alberta Employee allowed to drive a Government of Alberta vehicle?*" The main use of this type of MVIP is to confirm in real time the driver's licensing status and to update the Driver Management Information System (DMIS) in the Fleet Safety Office.

- Search Criteria

- An OL number for the registered owner (the driver) of an Alberta Operator's Licence.
- The Date of Birth of the driver

This type of SBF-RR MVIP provides current information on MOVES as of the Search PIT.

- This type of SBF-RR MVIP does not support looking back in time and consequently an Event PIT is not accepted.

- Information released as of the Search PIT:
 - Last Name.
 - If an alias, releases the current information from the primary of the relevant individual
 - Number of Demerit Points
 - Suspended: Y/N
 - Licence Issue Date
 - Licence Expiry Date
 - Licence Class
 - Condition Codes
 - GDL Status
 - Error message to be provided if:
 - No file is responsive on MOVES

II. Notification and Review Process

In accordance with s. 4 of AMVIR, on request by a Recipient identified above, the Registrar's decision is to **release**, on an ongoing basis, the information specified in this notification.

This notification was published on October 18, 2022. Any person may, within 60 days after the date of this publication, ask the Information and Privacy Commissioner (IPC) to review the decision of the Registrar in accordance with Part 5, Division 1.1 of the *Freedom of Information and the Protection of Privacy Act*.

On the publication of this notification, in accordance with s. 4(1) of AMVIR, notice is deemed to have been given for the current and any future releases of the category of information, and of the person or category of persons to whom the information is released/or is not released, as described in this notification, for the purposes of notice under Part 5, Division 1.1 of the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*.
