Technical Services Branch's new **Top 10 Design Things to Watch For** is a lighthearted look at some of the quality issues regularly seen in design review submissions. These are the things that keep TSB'ers up at night!

- 1. Jigs, Jogs, and Shaken Plans: Simple forms work best.
- 2. Crazy Roofs: Leaks love complexity.
- **3.** A Good Roof and Continuous Air Barrier: Keep it simple, buildable, and durable.
- 4. **Clerestories and Simpler Glass Shapes and Sizes:** Optimize window shape, size, location, natural light/views, and sun orientation.
- 5. **Projections (Canopies and Overhangs):** Avoid elements that compromise building envelope principles.
- **6.** Wasted Volumes: Right-size spaces in all 3 dimensions.
- **7. Future Growth:** Anticipate change; design for adaptability and flexibility.
- **8. Safe Sites:** Use best practices for safety and security.
- 9. Follow the Sun: Incorporate passive solar features that naturally benefit buildings and occupants.
- 10. Great Common Areas: Design for functionality and flexibility.

In addition to the list, TSB will be rolling out an accompanying Tech-Talk and "2-pager" summary. Used early, the *Top 10 Design Things to Watch For* can help intercept or prevent design issues before they get out of control. And maybe they'll help TSB'ers sleep a little more soundly at night!
