

Highway 27 Construction

Highway 27 through the Town of Sundre

Overview

Highway 27 is an important central Alberta highway. Alberta Transportation and Economic Corridors has planned improvements to Highway 27 through the Town of Sundre. The planning process has identified additional work that requires extension to the project timelines.

Project Details

The Highway 27 construction through the Town of Sundre will include the following improvements:

- Single lane roundabout at Highway 27/22/584/Range Road 54 (10th Street) intersection
- Permanent mini roundabouts at 2, 3, and 4 Street(West) intersections
- Intersection improvements at 1 Street (West) (right-in, right-out)
- Pavement rehabilitation, improvements to curbs, gutters, sidewalks, access management and lighting.

Following public engagement in 2022, additional improvements were identified including intersection upgrades at Centre Street, the Red Deer River bridge approach slabs, signalization of Highway 760 intersection, waterline relocations and additional lighting improvements.

The following timeline reflects the increased project scope:

- Summer 2023 – Complete preconstruction work including utility relocation (completed by the Town of Sundre)
- Fall 2023 – Project tender
- Spring 2024 – Construction start
- Fall 2024 – Construction completion
